February 1st is Chinese New Year; it's sometimes called the Spring Festival. Chinese New Year falls on the first New Moon of the year so the date changes each year. This year is the Chinese Year of the Tiger. There are 12 animals in the Chinese Animal Zodiac

Chinese New Year lasts about 2 weeks and during this time people eat lots of delicious food, children are given special red envelopes with money gifts inside and then paint lanterns to end the festival.

The Tiger is the 3nd animal in the Chinese Animal Zodiac. In a race for the Emperor to name the years, an ox gave a rat a lift, only to be cheated by the rat who jumped off the ox and then won the race. The rat was cunning and the ox was too trusting. The tiger, who was very tired, came 3rd. The Emperor named the 3rd year The Year of The Tiger.

Dreamcatcher

Making a dream catcher is a great way for kids get a restful sleep.

To make your own dreamcatcher you will need

A paper plate
A hole punch
Scissors
Feathers
String or wool
Glue
Glitter (optional)

First fold the plate and cut a semi circle out along the inner rim of the plate. Next use a hole punch to punch holes around the outer rim of the plate.





Cut off 3 or 4 strands of string or wool and weave the wool through the holes. On the last hole, pull the wool through and then tie or glue a feather to the end. We recommend not using beads due to their small size. Keep threading wool until you have enough pieces hanging from the bottom of the dreamcatcher. Then hang on your bedroom wall for happy dreams
