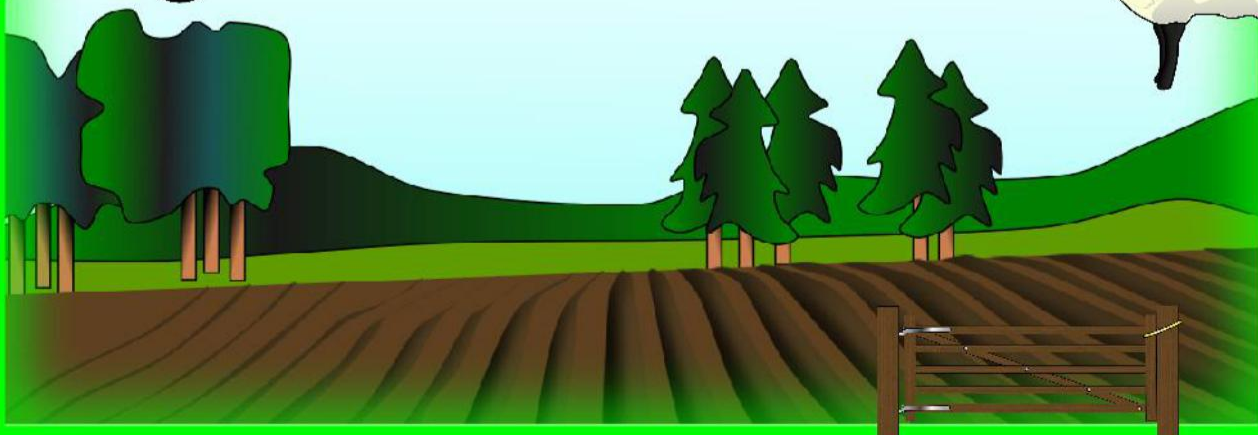
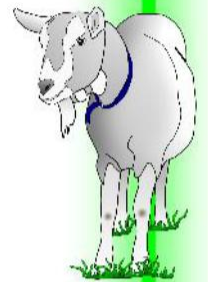
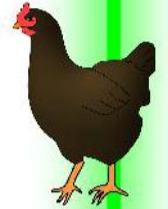
Scarecrow Craft

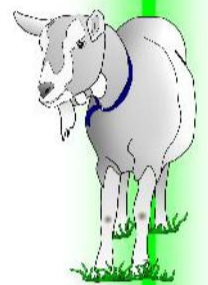
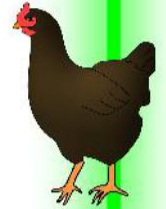
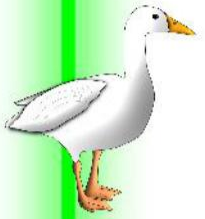
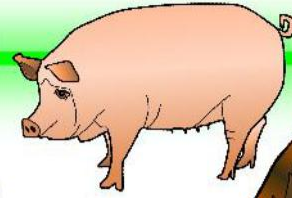
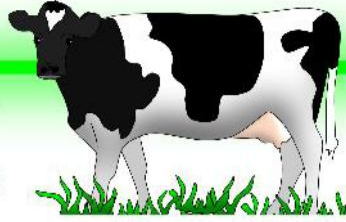


1. Gather your materials. You will need five different colour pieces of coloured paper orange, green, yellow, neutral and light blue (you can paint or colour white paper to make the pieces), two large googly eyes (you can draw the eyes on with a marker), scissors and a glue stick.
2. Start by drawing a scarecrow head and mouth. Cut this out.

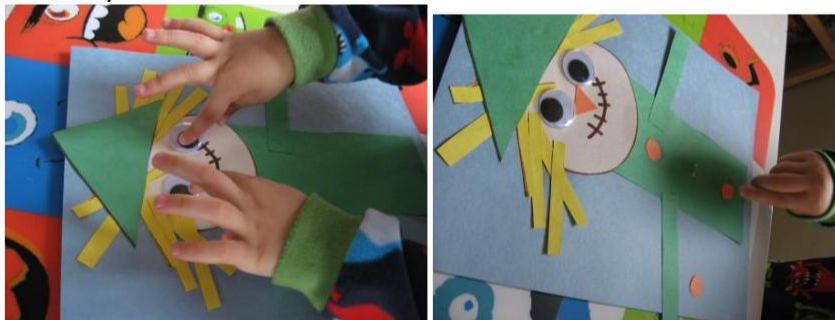
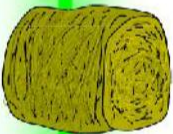
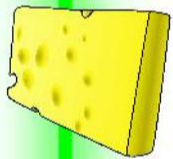


3. Next cut out (or have your child cut out while supervising) a triangle hat and rectangle shirt and arms from the green paper. Cut out many smaller rectangles from the yellow paper for hair.





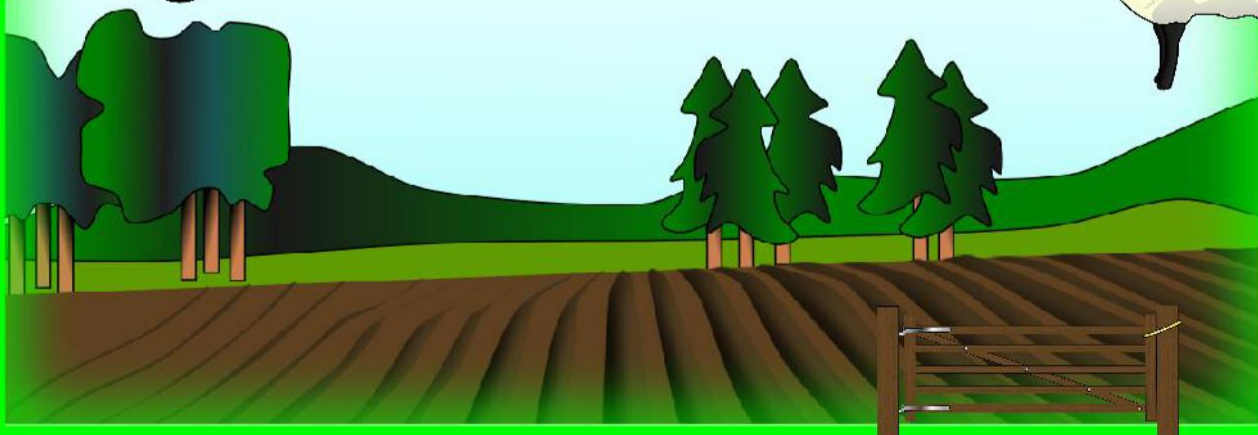
4. Cut out an orange triangle for the nose and three orange circles for the buttons.
5. Start gluing. Show your child the shapes and ask them what they look like. Glue it on. Don't forget to ask what each shape is or label the shape for them. Next, add the head.
6. Keep labelling and adding the shapes as you build your scarecrow craft. Ask the child questions, what is this part? is this his head? etc.
7. Add the arms.
8. If you are doing this with young toddlers, don't forget to label the colours as well! Add the hat! Then, add the eyes and nose. Add your buttons.

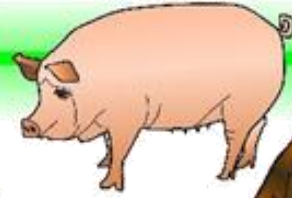


9. Let your scarecrow dry!



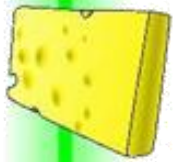

Using the following recipe make some playdough and create some ducks and eggs for the playdough mats attached.



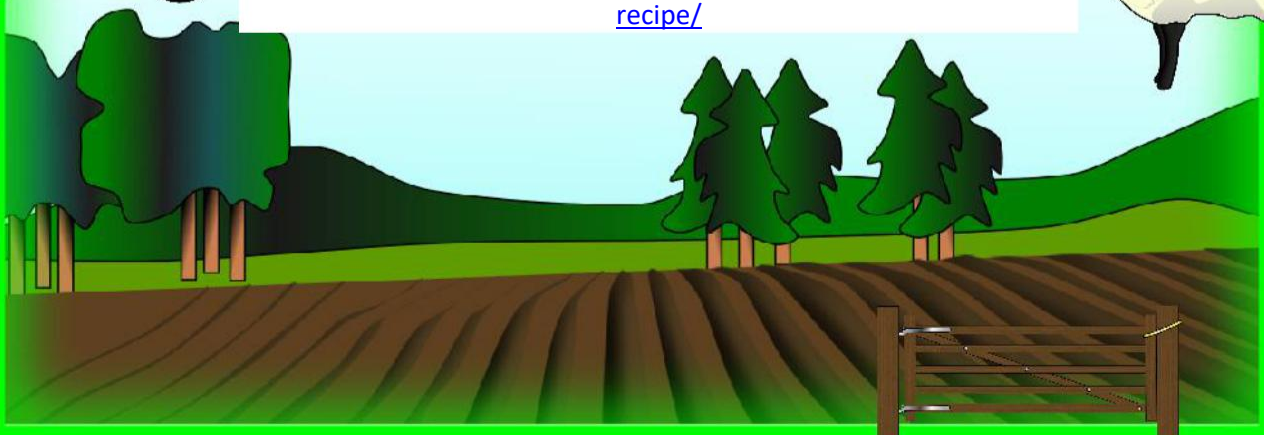

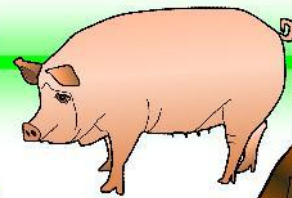
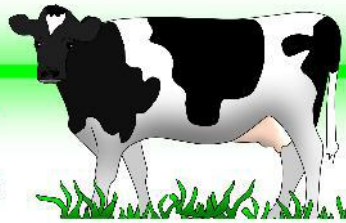
Repeat the process with a different food colouring if you want more than one colour.
